

YARMOUTH REGIONAL HOSPITAL

The Yarmouth Regional Hospital (YRH) is a multi-specialty 124-bed hospital with full integration of family medicine and specialties within a collegial, multidisciplinary environment. We provide care to approximately 60,000 people in Shelburne, Yarmouth and Digby Counties. Yarmouth is the major academic site for the population of Southwest Nova Scotia.

RESIDENCY PROGRAMS

Yarmouth serves as the Southwest Nova teaching site for Dalhousie Family Medicine and General Internal Medicine Residency programs.



ELECTIVES IN SOUTHWEST NS

Each year our physicians host medical learners visiting from across Nova Scotia, Canada, and the world! With opportunities for electives in Primary Maternity Care, Emergency Medicine, Hospitalist, Pediatrics, General Internal Medicine, and more, Yarmouth Regional Hospital is a fantastic place to get a feel for what community medicine is all about!

LO-COME-FROM-AWAY

The provincial locum program, administered by the Department of Health and Wellness through MSI, provides a guaranteed minimum daily income of \$1,200 for family physicians and \$1,600 for specialists (actual earnings are often higher), coverage for travel expenses, and support for licensing fees.

- Licensing: College licensing fees will be paid for out-of-province locum physicians. For Atlantic
 physicians, the cost of the Atlantic registry will be paid; for other out-of-province physicians, the cost of
 a locum license will be paid.
- Overhead: Paid at \$250 per day.
- Call Stipend: Paid on top of other payments when locum physician is covering call.
- Minimum Income Guarantee: If the locum physician shadow bills above the minimum daily rate, the
 excess is paid to the locum physician at 100% (No payment for services delivered after-hours, unless
 billings exceed the daily guarantee).
